PARK RULES

For your safety and enjoyment, we ask you to abide by the following rules and regulations in our parks and recreation facilities.

- 1) Glass beverage containers are prohibited.
- 2) Fireworks are prohibited at all times.
- 3) Vehicles are restricted to roads and parking lots.
- 4) Fires are restricted to fire pits and grills.
- 5) Posters and advertisements are prohibited.
- 6) It is illegal to carry a weapon into any park area.
- 7) Pets must be on a leash, and you MUST clean up after your pets.
- 8) Hunting, trapping and/or killing of animals or birds is prohibited.
- 9) No overnight camping in City Parks.
- 10) **Alcohol permits are required and may be purchased at RFCC.**

PICNIC SHELTER RESERVATION

Picnic shelters at Spring Lake Park, Davidson Park, Recreation Park, Harmon Park, Dakota Park and Moose Park may be reserved for a \$25.00 fee. All reservations must be made in person between the hours of 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday at the Raymond Family Community Center. Shelters are not guaranteed until the \$25 fee is received. Refunds will only be given in the event of inclement weather. A reserved sign will be posted on the shelter the day of the reservation. In addition to picnic shelters, volleyball net and ball are available for public use.

RENT THE SPECIAL EVENT TENT

This wonderful 100' x 60' large tent is quite a popular attraction for special events in the Williston area. It is available for rent through the Parks & Recreation Department. If you are planning a reunion, church gathering, community celebration or other event, the special event tent is available to various groups upon request. **A \$500.00 *Refundable Security Deposit + Rental Fee is Due at the time of tent rental.** (*Security Deposit will be refunded, provided the tent is returned without any damage.) Policies

ACTIVITY ASSISTANCE

Adjusted rates are available for recreation programs for youth grades 12 and below for qualified families. For additional information, contact the Parks & Recreation Office at 577-5141.

INSURANCE

The Williston Parks & Recreation District does not carry medical or accident insurance for the participants of our programs. The cost of doing so would be so high that fees charged for programs would become prohibitive. We suggest that you review your family's personal health insurance plan to be sure that it provides you with sufficient coverage. We also suggest that you check with your family physician before participating in any parks and recreation district programs that require physical exertion. If your physician should discover factors that are physically limiting, please consider those factors when registering for programs.

CREDIT POLICY

A 100% credit is available if you withdraw from a program before it begins. Registration fees will not be refunded once the program has begun, with the exception of a medical reason.



WEATHER POLICY FOR THE OUTDOOR POOL

*The outdoor pool will be open if the air temperature is 65 degrees by noon, or if the weather forecast is favorable to be warmer as the day progresses.

*The pool will be closed if the air temperature is below 65 degrees and the weather forecast is for the temperature to remain lower than 65 degrees for the day.

*The pool will be closed immediately during threatening weather, such as, but not limited to, thunder/lightning, high winds, and rain.

*The pool manager will make the decision to open or close the pool for the afternoon session by 12:00 (noon) daily. The evening session decision will be made by 4:30.

YOUR CHILD & ORGANIZED SPORTS

- 2) Weigh the time spent on sports against that for other important activities.
- 3) Know how many hours and days your child will be involved in practice, games and tournaments.
- 4) Find out about goals and quality of adults in the program.
- 5) Know that each player gets to play.
- 6) Plan on how you will behave when your child is not a winner, "a bench warmer", or wants to quit.
- 7) Ask if parents are expected at practices or games.
- 8) Be ready for expenses of uniforms, fees, and Transportation.

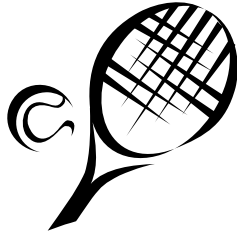

LEARN-TO-SWIM LEVELS

The American Red Cross Swimming and Water Safety Program features six new levels of Learn-to-Swim. The objectives for each level include:

Level 1: - Introduction to Water Skills. Helps students feel comfortable in the water and enjoy the water safely.

Level 2: - Fundamental Aquatic Skills. Gives students success with fundamental skills.

Level 3: - Stroke Development. Builds on the skills in Level 2 by providing additional guided practice.

Level 4: - Stroke Improvement. Develops confidence in the strokes learned and improves other aquatic skills.

Level 5: - Stroke Refinement. Provides further coordination and refinement of strokes.

Level 6: - Swimming and Skill Proficiency. Refines the strokes so students swim them with ease, efficiency, power and smoothness over greater distances. Level 6 is designed with "menu" options. Each of these options include:

- Personal Water Safety
- Fundamentals of Diving
- Lifeguard Readiness
- Fitness Swimming
